- Support the negotiation and management of technology transfer agreements (e.g., NDAs, MTAs and licensing agreements), in articulation with legal/administrative services;
- Monitoring and reporting of technology transfer and innovation KPIs (e.g., disclosures, patent filings, licensing/partnering activities, funding efforts).

##### Mandatory Requirements:

- PhD in Pharmaceutical, Biomedical or Biological Sciences;
- More than 5 years of experience in biomedical research and/or in the biotech / pharma industry;
- Relevant experience in research related with the discovery and development of novel drugs and advanced therapies;
- Basic understanding of technology transfer goals and activities;
- Excellent command of English, both spoken and written.

**Desirable Requirements:**

- Relevant experience in experimental design, especially for studies at discovery and preclinical stage;
- Relevant experience in preparing and writing grant proposals for research and innovation projects;
- Basic knowledge of and experience with AI tools.

**Analysis of Curriculum Vitae (70%):**

- Scientific background, work experience and other relevant activities (25%);
- Relevant experience, knowledge and skills for the position (45%)

**Motivation letter (30%):**

- Motivation and interest for the position (20%);
- Excellent command of English, both spoken and written (10%).
